## Other Oldenburg Pioneers

In several past Corners, I presented information on the founder of Minster, Franz Joseph Stallo, and on the founders of Saint Henry, Johann Heinrich, Johann. Bernard, Franz, and Johann. Joseph Römer. Stallo and the Römer brothers all hailed from Damme, Oldenburg. In west-central Ohio there were other Oldenburgers, like Stallo and the Römers, who were associated with the establishment of some of the smaller parishes and settlements. These were Johann Heinrich Schlarmann at Saint Rose, Johann Heinrich Krumpelmann jetzt Wempen-Wieners at Philothea, Johann Heinrich Wichelmann at Saint Anthony, and Johann Adelhard Osterloh at Egypt.

He sold 10 acres on 9 April 1842 to Bishop John Baptist Purcell for the parish.

He sold 40 acres on 3 January 1851 to Bishop John Baptist Purcell for the parish and the village.

He sold several acres on 11 September 1852 to Archbishop John Baptist Purcell for the parish cemetery, and he sold to the Society of the Precious Blood, 80 acres of land in 1856 for the convent.
